The Bass Coast Landcare Public Fund is a regional non-profit organisation comprised of five (5) independent board members. It focuses on conserving biodiversity throughout Bass Coast.

We do this by supporting community groups to work in their local area to add value to their conservation efforts, encourage broader community ownership and participation and by working in partnership with other land managers. We help protect native plants and animals in Bass Coast's most ecologically important landscapes.

The Bass Coast Arc – “Community Access to Public Space” concept was dreamt up by passionate members of the Bass Coast community.

Through the Bass Coast Arc project, the Bass Coast Landcare Public Fund (BCLPF) aims to support community groups to improve the environment of our public spaces and create community access to these unique areas.
