Over the years it has transitioned into a beef farm and since 2005 Dani and Brad have been slowly revegetating strategic areas. Remnant bushland areas have also been protected and are slowly being enhanced. The farm has greatly benefited from this work with the cattle having access to more valuable shade and shelter along with increased habitat for local native wildlife including insects. 'A win-win for everyone'.**
