Trees for Public Land Project Funding**

Dear BCLN Landcare Groups,

We are pleased to inform you that the Bass Coast Landcare Network (BCLN) Public Fund has allocated \$10,000 raised at the BCLN Art Show to support a Trees for Public Land Project. This funding is now available for Expressions of Interest (EOI) from BCLN Landcare groups to apply for funding towards the cost of indigenous plants for Public Land projects within your group area.

**Key Details:**

- **Funding Available:** Up to \$2000 per Landcare group minimum project \$500
- **Eligibility:** The group must have approval from the relevant Public Land Manager for the planting of the plants before applying.

2. **Public Land Site Address**
3. **Land Manager Details**
4. **Do you have Land Manager consent? (Yes/No)**
5. **Please explain the environmental benefits of your project.**
6. **How many community members do you believe will be involved in the project?**
7. **Please provide a photo of the site and a site map.**
8. **How many plants do you require, and what is the Environmental Vegetation Class (EVC)?** (BCLN staff can assist with this information.)

**EOI Deadline and submission details**

EOIs will be accepted until **June 30, 2026**, and will be assessed by the Public Fund trustees at their July meeting. Landcare groups are also encouraged to partner with Friends of groups or other conservation groups on these projects.
