

Bass Coast Landcare Network- Book Launch and Farm walk. 'Deep Time- And the implications for a Sustainable Agriculture'.

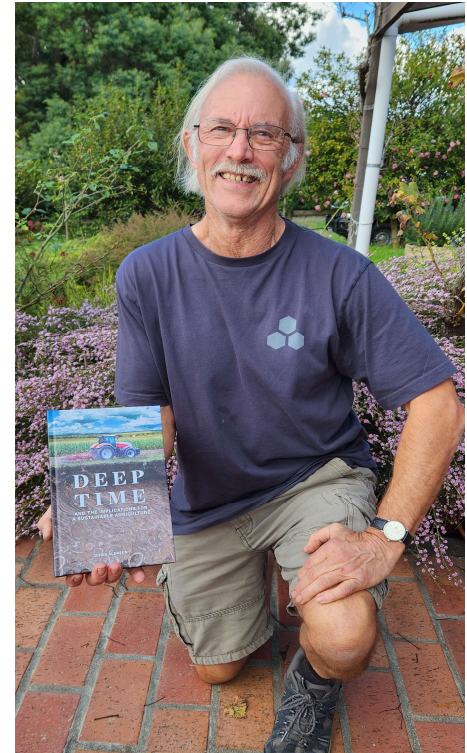
